

## 4-H Best Rabbit Project Sponsored by “Friends of the Youth Rabbit Project”

### Purpose

The **Friends of the Youth Rabbit Project** group was formed to encourage and acknowledge excellence among youth in their 4-H rabbit projects. We aspire to encourage 4-Hers to develop the scope of their project, engage in project activities and conduct themselves with the poise and conduct of a leader to others in the project and community.

### Eligibility

Applicant must be a current enrolled member in good standing with a Sonoma County or Marin County 4-H rabbit project. Applicant must be exhibiting rabbits at the 2019 Sonoma Marin Fair. Exhibitor to compete according to age as of January 1, 2019.

Three awards will be given:

1. 4-H Best Rabbit Project 9-10 years
2. 4-H Best Rabbit Project 11-13 years
3. 4-H Best Rabbit Project 14 years and over

### Rules

1. Applicants agree to be available and complete the interview as scheduled. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
2. Applications are to be completed by the contestant and **in their own words**.
3. Applicants will be required to submit a written application and attend an interview on the scheduled day at their assigned time.
4. Application may be typed or handwritten. Application not to exceed five pages in length, including cover page if typed. Seven page maximum if hand written. A minimum of size 11 font and half inch margins on 8.5” x 11” paper must be used if typed.
6. Include first and last name with page number on top of each page of application.
7. Applicants are expected to interview in professional 4-H attire appropriate for the 4-H rabbit project. This includes white pants, long sleeve white shirt, 4-H scarf/tie and 4-H hat.
8. If any given category lacks a qualified candidate, award will not be given.
9. *Scholarship and award recipients are decided by the scholarship or award sponsor, and their decisions are independent of the Sonoma-Marin Fair. The Sonoma-Marin Fair serves as venue for the application and presentation of the awards.*

### Procedure

The application is due to the fair office by 5 p.m. on Friday, June 7, 2019.

Interviews will be held assigned after all applications are received at the Sonoma-Marin Fairgrounds. After all applications are received, candidates will be contacted with their interview time.

Award winners will be determined from the sum of their application and interview scores. Award will be presented at Sunday awards ceremony.

The ideal candidate will demonstrate commitment to their project with strong goals. Leadership and community service within the project is encouraged. Appropriate levels of leadership and project development will be taken into consideration with age and number of years in the project.
